As Suffolk's highest-ranking law enforcement official, he serves and protects our residents through innovative programs to reduce crime and recidivism, eradicate the drug epidemic, and work to put an end to human trafficking. Sheriff Toulon has his Doctorate in Educational Administration, a Masters in Business Administration.

Promoting prison contraband including drugs and weapons introduced by newly admitted inmates, attempts to utilize the mail or pass during visiting are among the most common.

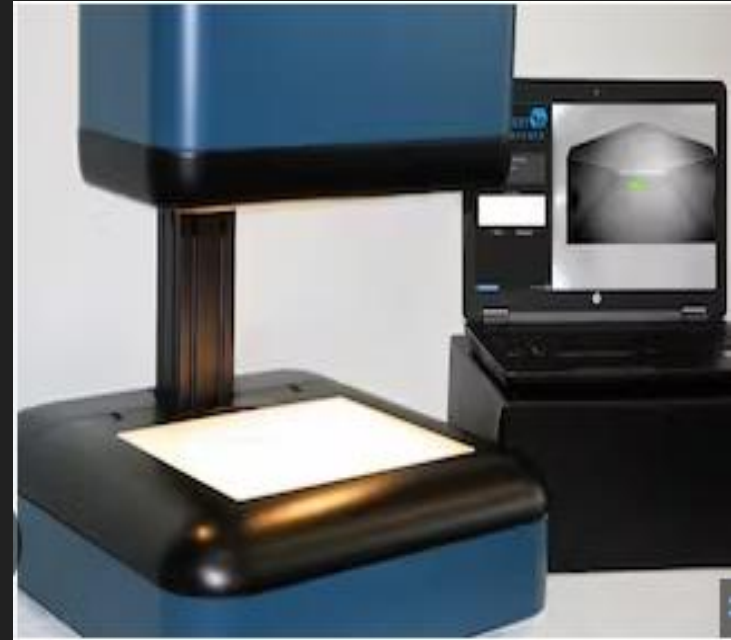
Promoting Prison Contraband

Drugs inside the jail are worth ten times the street value when inside the jail, making them lucrative and dangerous causing fights, disturbances, and medical emergencies.

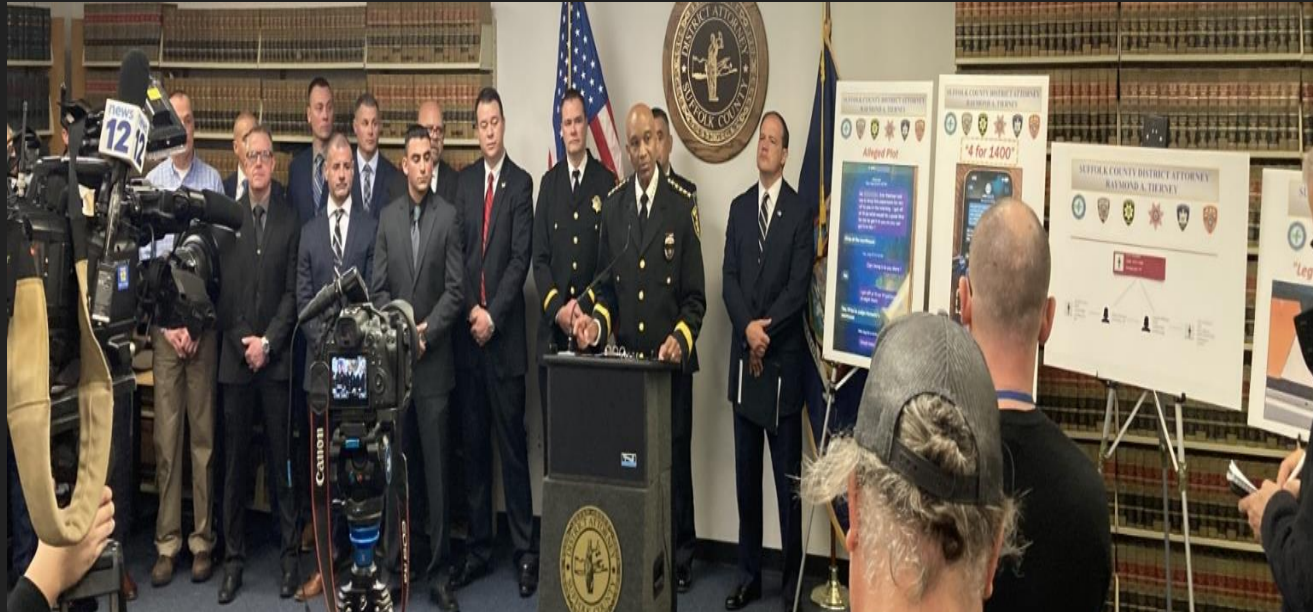
Recent Example

The Corrections Intelligence Center, Criminal Investigations Bureau, Internal Security, District Attorneys Fentanyl Task Force, and N.Y.S. Courts Collaborated on a two month investigation into conspiracy to traffic over an ounce of fentanyl worth over \$20,000 into the jail through court paperwork

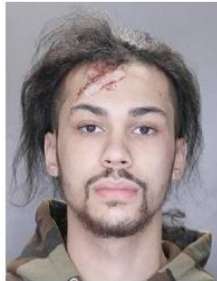

COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE MAKES FENTANYL, HEROIN, AND CRACK ARREST PASSENGER ARRESTED, DRIVER STILL AT LARGE

(MEDFORD, NY) On Friday, March 25, 2022, at approximately 3:50 p.m., Suffolk County Sheriff's Deputies were traveling westbound on the Long Island Expressway, east of exit 67 in a marked unit when they observed a 2020 Mazda bearing Georgia license plates traveling at a high rate of speed with two male occupants inside.

Deputies stopped the vehicle, and while approaching the vehicle, the vehicle sped away. It exited the Long Island Expressway at exit 65 and crashed into a telephone pole at the corner of Falcon Ave. in Medford.

The front seat passenger, Edward Smith, 20, of Yaphank, NY, fled on foot and was apprehended a short distance away. The driver fled the scene and is still at large.

A quantity of drugs including over 3 grams of Fentanyl, over 3 grams of Heroin, over 6 grams of Crack Cocaine, 14 suboxone pills, a small quantity of marijuana, a stun gun, and \$3,240.00 in cash were discovered in the vehicle and on the scene.

Passenger Edward Smith was charged with: three counts of Possession of a Controlled Substance in the 3rd and one count of Possession of a Controlled Substance in the 5th.

The vehicle has been impounded and an investigation is ongoing.

Suffolk County Sheriff Errol D. Toulon, Jr. commends his deputies for their vigilance. "Suffolk County Deputy Sheriffs are patrolling our county's roads day and night to keep the public safe. A seemingly straightforward traffic stop for speeding can turn into a dangerous situation for the deputies and the public when the driver attempts to flee. In this case, thankfully no one was seriously injured and Deputies took dangerous drugs off the streets. I thank my deputies for their hard work."

YAPHANK, NY — The driver of a car that sped away from deputy sheriffs on the [Long Island Expressway](#) before crashing nearby was arrested at his home in Yaphank on Wednesday after being at large for five days, Suffolk Sheriff Errol Toulon's office said.

An "extensive investigation" was conducted by the Criminal Investigations Bureau, including evidence collected at the scene and security camera video, and led investigators to 20-year-old Daniel Mason, who was arrested as he left his home by deputies who were conducting surveillance, the office said.

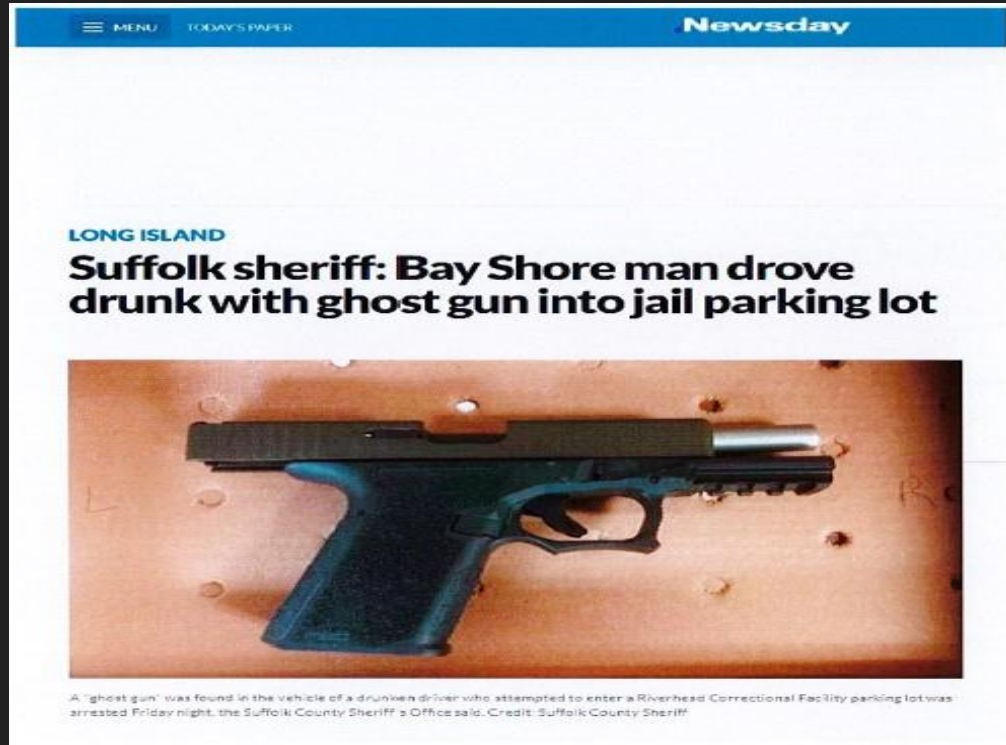

The Santa Fe Sheriff's Office and New Mexico First Judicial District Attorney's Office are "actively working" with the Suffolk County Sheriff's Office and Baldwin's lawyers to get the phone, an official told Fox News.

On Dec. 16, Santa Fe authorities issued a search warrant for Baldwin's phone because they believed it contains key conversations related to what led to the prop-gun death of cinematographer Halyna Hutchins in October.

But the 63-year-old actor has yet to turn the phone over to New Mexico cops, the Suffolk County Sheriff's Department said Friday.

"The Suffolk County Sheriff's Office has received a request from the Santa Fe, NM authorities requesting assistance in obtaining Alec Baldwin's phone," Sergeant Paul Spinella told Fox News.

"This request has been forwarded to the Suffolk County District Attorney's Office to work out the differences in laws between NM and NY. As this is an ongoing investigation, that is all the Suffolk County Sheriff's Office can report at this time," he said.

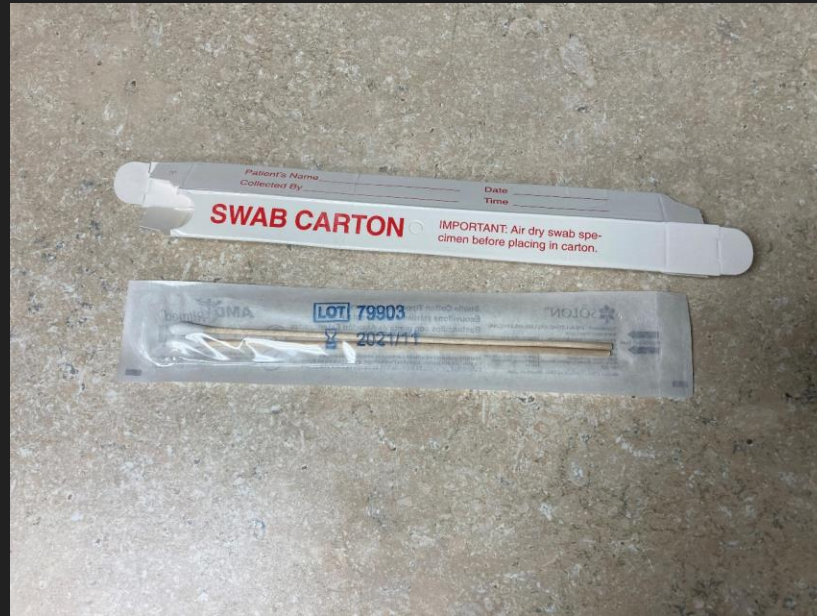

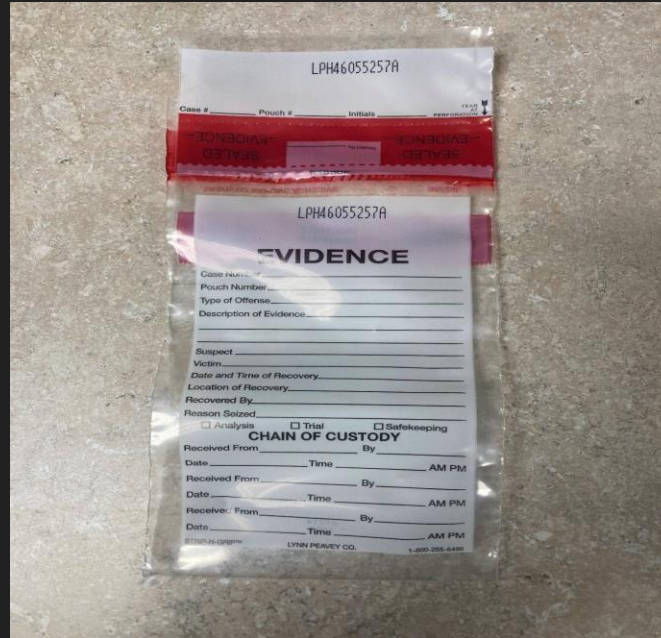

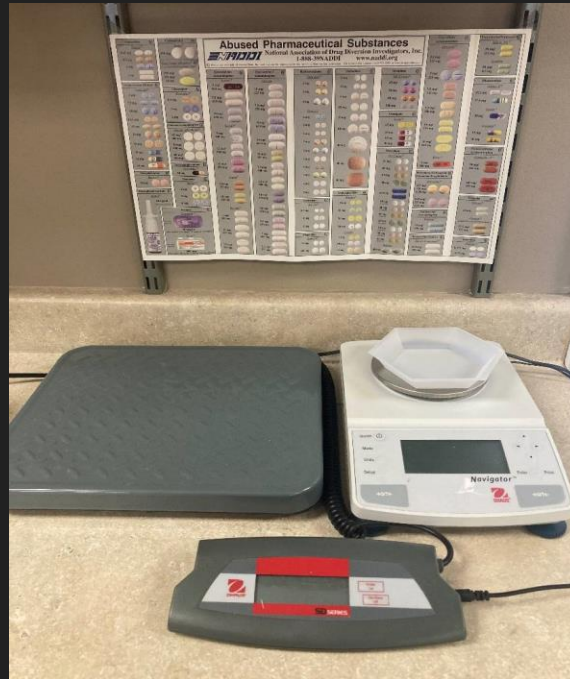
